Dear Sir:

The Louisiana Auctioneers Licensing Board has determined that you have violated the board's order rendered on August 28, 1986. That order put you on probation for one year and as a condition of probation commanded that you pay a \$500.00 fine and \$700.00 in cost to the board and that you deposit \$1,200.00 in the trust account of your attorney. The fine and costs were to be paid one-half within 10 days and one-half within 30 days.

At the board's meeting of October 24, 1986, it was determined that you had paid only \$600.00 to the board and had failed to pay the other one-half of the fine and costs within the time limits ordered and further, that you had failed to deposit the \$1,200.00 in your attorney's trust account.

The board thereupon voted unanimously to revoke your license as of October 24, 1986. As Mr. Hemphill was informed, you are ordered to return your current license to the Board immediately. A hearing will be held on November 13, 1986, at 1:30 p.m. to allow you to show cause why your license should be returned to you.
